PIONEERING SOLUTIONS IN THE BATTLE AGAINST FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE

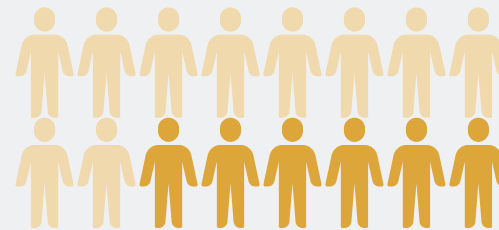

In responding to the issue, the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (FKH) contributes to offer **pragmatic guidance on safe meat consumption practices due to the FMD crisis**. By educating people through outreach programs, we empowering individuals to be informed about dietary choices.

UNAIR has also supported the villages including Gresik, Lamongan, and Blora. We send out veterinary specialist and volunteers comprehensive services through educational outreach.
